



State-Mandated Assessments and Right to Request Student Achievement Levels

This school year, ACPA students are required to take the following state mandated exams:

AIR (American Institutes for Research) End of Course Exams

- Students in grades 9 through 12 who are enrolled in the following courses: English 9, English 10, Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, US History and US Government.

AIR End of Course Exam Retakes

- Students in the classes of 2018, 2019 and 2020 who have previously tested in the above subjects, but have not met the minimum required graduation points will retake one or more test. Counselors will notify students who need to retake exams and intervention will be available to help students prepare.

ACT (College Entrance Exam)

- All students in the class of 2019 will take the ACT at ACPA this year. This administration of the ACT is free for students. Students electing to take the ACT at another time outside of ACPA are responsible for the fee of that administration.

Additionally, parents and guardians have the right to request information regarding their student's achievement levels on any state-mandated test administered at ACPA.
